English

*The Lion and the Unicorn by Shirley Hughes

They will explore a range of grammatical concepts and will write a range of diary entries, letters, character comparisons, setting descriptions and finish by writing their own evacuation narrative.

*Odd and the Frost Giant by Neil Gaiman & Chris Riddell

They will explore a range of grammatical concepts and take part in drama activities. They will write an explanation as well as a narrative.

*The Matchbox Diary by Paul Fleischman

The children will discover a set of matchboxes containing some of the mementoes from the story. After writing predictions about what the objects might relate to, the children will listen to the story in stages.
