English – Crossing Borders

Romeo and Juliet by William Shakespeare (Real Reads version retold by Helen Street) - Diaries, letters, narratives, character descriptions, balanced argument
A Beautiful Lie by Irfan Master - Narrative (Adventure), Journalistic Writing, Recounts, Discussion text

French

The children will continue to receive specialist teaching.

History – Leisure & Entertainment

Children will learn about the rise in popularity of cinema, about how and why football became the nation's favourite sport, the social and cultural importance of the 'Swinging Sixties', why British holiday camps emerged and how television has impacted modern life. Children will also learn about how developments in 20th century technology can make life in this century easier.

Art – 3D (Henry Moore)

Children will combine and organise line, shape, pattern and form to match their intentions. They will collect and select visual and other information in developing ideas for their work and record from first-hand observation directly into 3D form.

Science – Light

Children will learn about light, shadow, reflection, refraction, how light travels & how we see objects. They will gain knowledge about Isaac Newton and his theory of light, colour, discovery and ideas.

PE

Jasmine Real PE (Health & Fitness): Children will self-select and perform appropriate warm-up and cool down activities. They will identify possible dangers when planning an activity. They will work on their static balance stance and coordination of footwork.

Music – Music and Me

Children will focus upon the important and inspirational role women have in the music industry. They will learn about and understand some of the ways that inspirational women in the music industry express their own identity in the music they create and perform. Children will then create their own music.

Heartsmart – Fake is a mistake
