Geography:

Enough for Everyone

Children will cover objectives which look at renewable and non-renewable energy sources. They will formulate ideas about saving resources whilst gaining knowledge about where our food comes from alongside points of how to conserve resources and help the planet. Studies will include:

- Wind power
- Solar power
- Hydro-power

Children will consider the need to conserve food, water and energy supplies to help the planet and future generations.

Science - Properties & Changes of Materials

- compare & group together everyday materials on basis of their properties.
- know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form solution & describe how to recover substance from solution
- use knowledge of solids, liquids & gases to decide how mixtures might be separated. • give reasons, based on evidence from comparative & fair tests, for particular uses of everyday materials.
- demonstrate that dissolving, mixing & changes of state are reversible changes
explain that some changes result in formation of new materials, & that this kind of change is not usually reversible, including changes associated with burning & action of acid on bicarbonate of soda.
