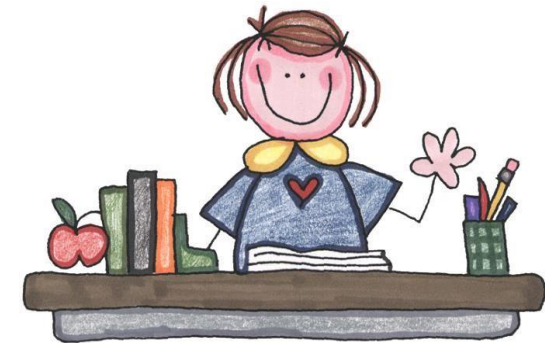

Religious Education - Signs & Symbols

Children will explore, through stories, the key teachings & beliefs of Hindus. They will gain knowledge of the key features of Hindu places of worship & some signs, symbols and artefacts.

Marvellous Maps

This topic allows children to further explore the range of maps available to geographers and to develop their understanding of the key features of maps.

Children will study a range of maps and atlases, including digital maps, and compare their features. They will learn the eight compass points to give directions and give grid references to locate places on a map.

By comparing maps of the same place, children will learn about the way that places have changed over time.

Computing - Radio Station

Children will continue to use software and digital devices for recording sound. It will encourage a creative approach that includes interviewing, making adverts and using jingles. They will also write scripts and design additional advertising for their Radio Station.
